What is personal data?

What is the processing of personal data?

Processing of personal data means any operation or set of operations performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.

The controller is not obliged to appoint a Data Protection Officer.

Sources and categories of personal data:

The controller processes personal data (directly from you) which you have provided or which was obtained for the purpose of fulfilling your order.

Your identification and contact data, and data necessary for fulfilling the contract.

Legal basis and purpose of processing:

The legal basis for processing is:

- Your consent to the processing of personal data for direct marketing purposes under Article 6(1)(a) GDPR
- Fulfilment of a contract between you and the controller under Article 6(1)(b) GDPR

Processing necessary for compliance with a legal obligation under Article 6(1)(c)

The purpose of processing personal data is:

Data retention period:

The controller stores personal data:

- For the time necessary to fulfill rights and obligations arising from the contract and to exercise claims arising from these relationships.
- Until consent for marketing purposes is withdrawn.
- After the statutory retention period under Act No. 395/2002 Coll. on Archives and Registries, personal data will be deleted.

Recipients of personal data

A recipient is any person to whom personal data are provided, whether or not they are a third party.

Authorities processing data under a special regulation are not considered recipients. Recipients may include persons involved in delivering goods, services, or processing payments.

The controller does not provide or make personal data available to third countries.

Personal data security measures

The controller declares that appropriate personal, technical, and organizational measures have been taken to ensure data protection.

Technical measures include securing data storage and paper-based records.

Only authorized persons have access to personal data.
